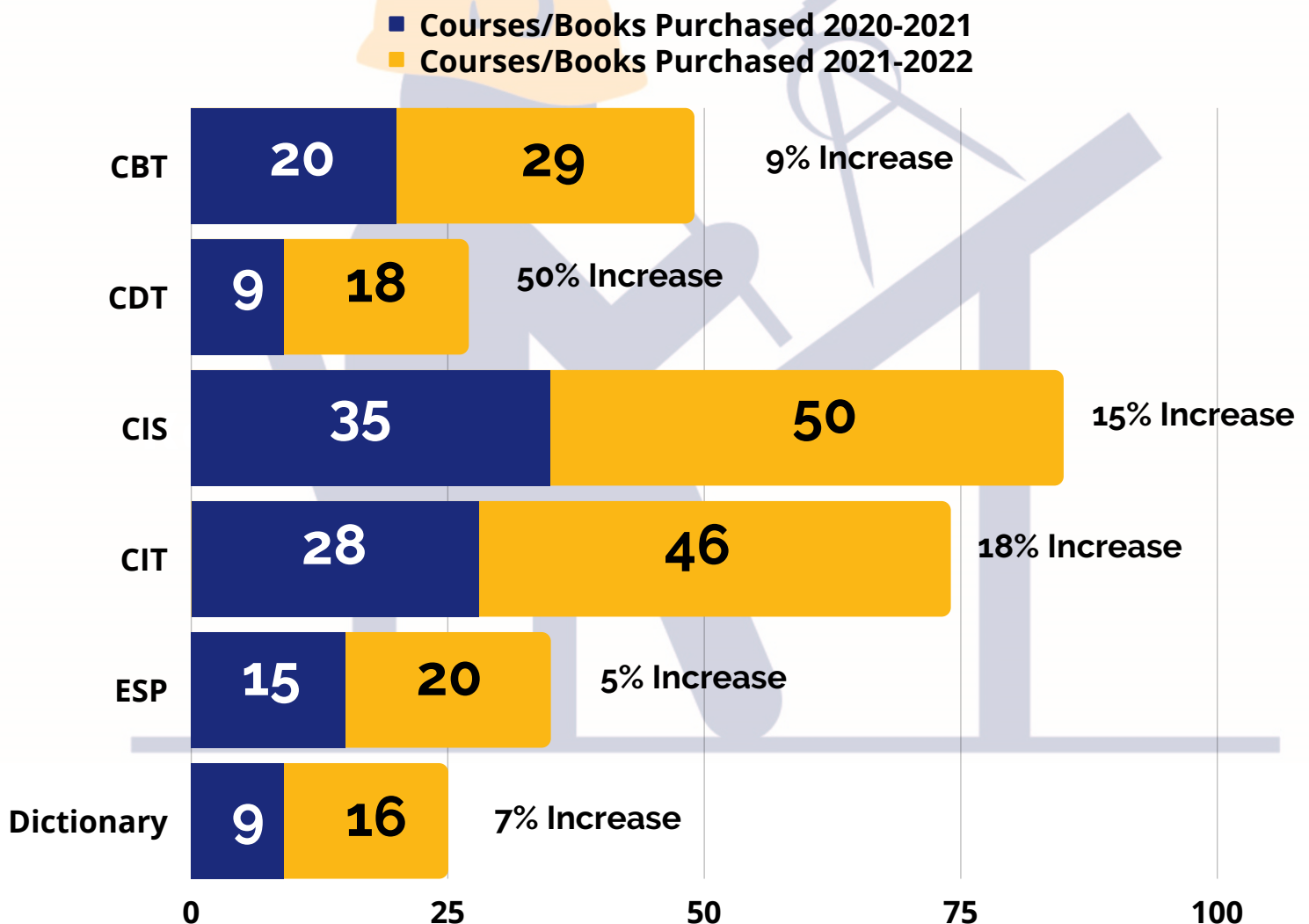

Testing Results

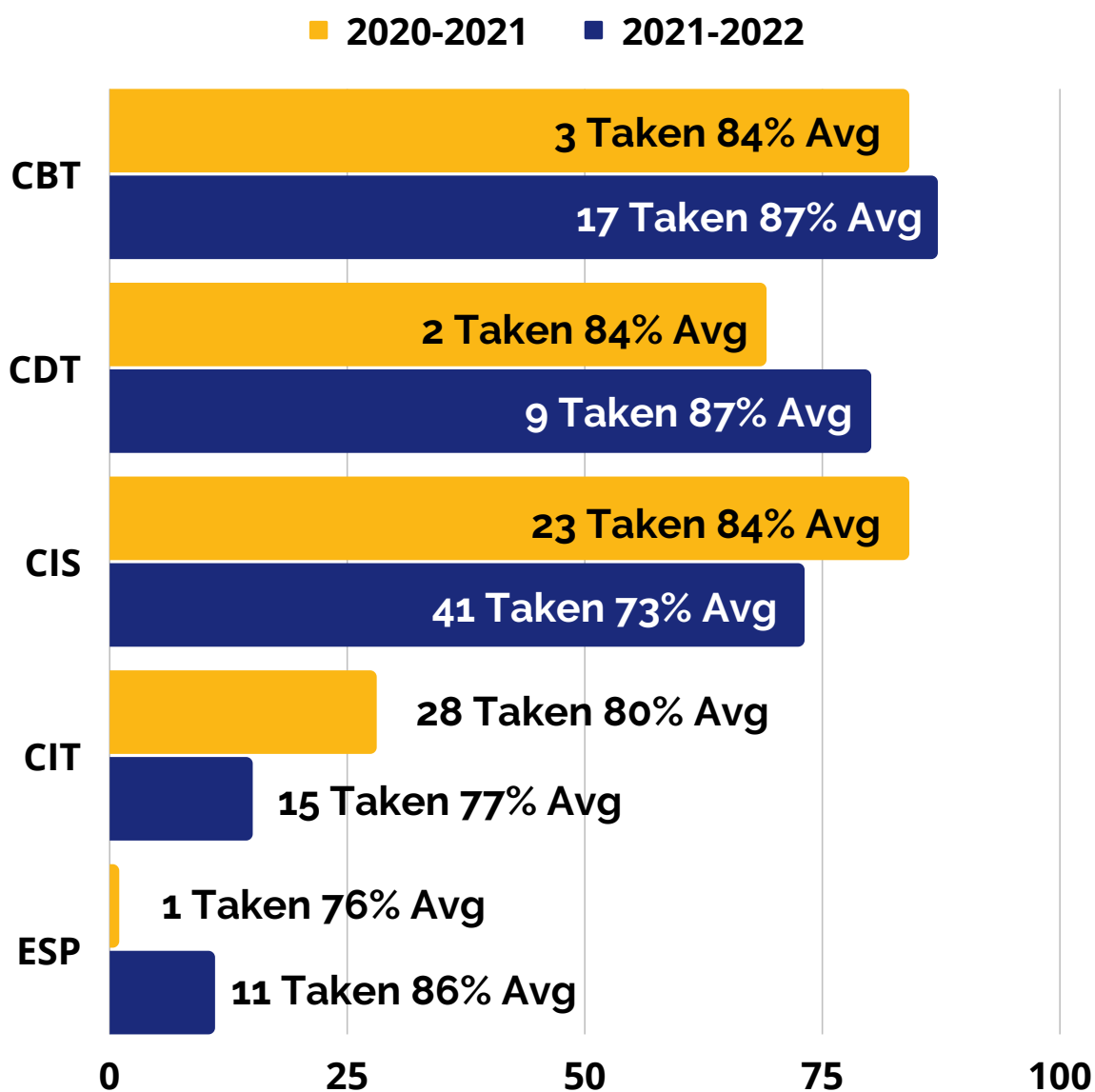

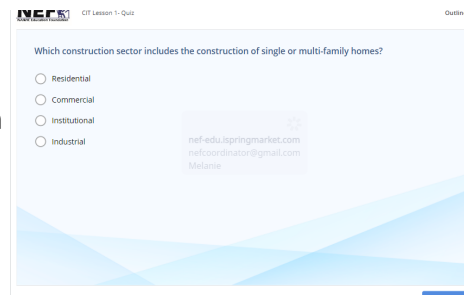
CHAPTER REVIEWS

CHAPTER REVIEW QUESTION ANSWERS

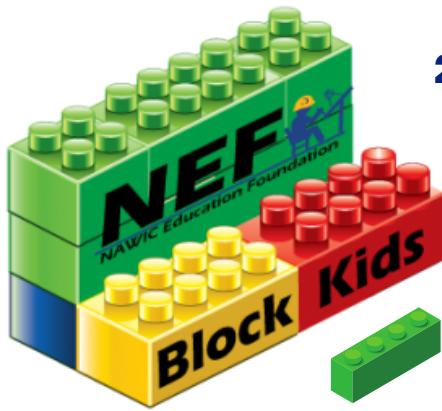

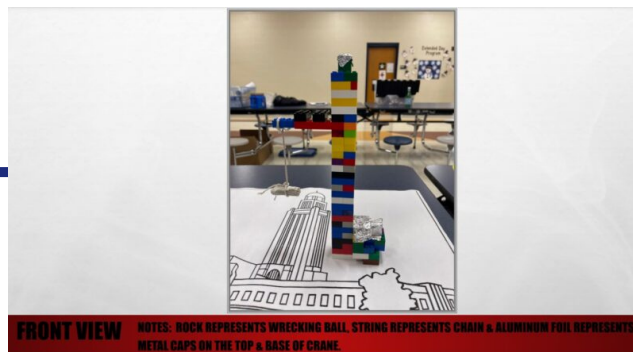

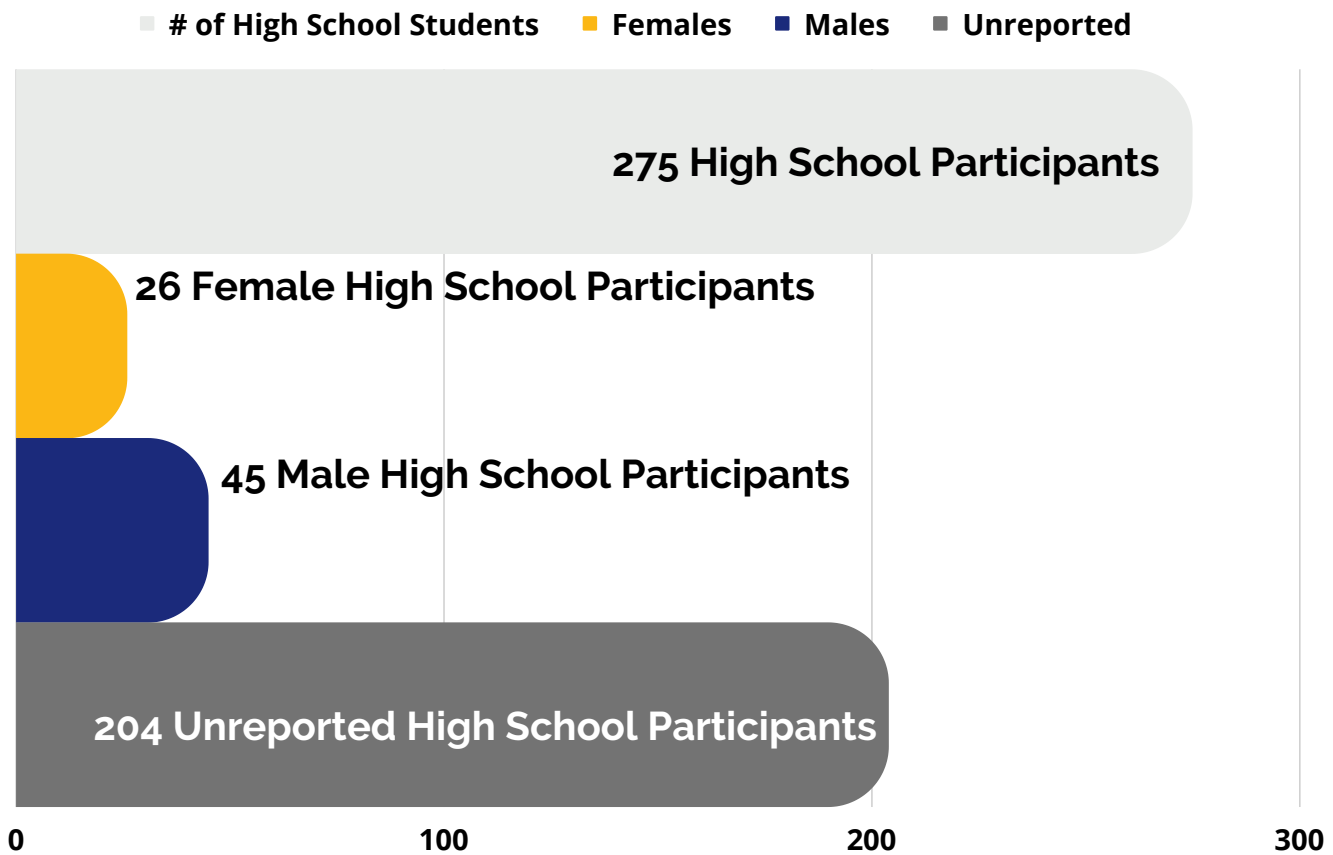
